The Yorkshire Air Museum welcomes groups from the above and other youth organisations for educational visits. Our Aviation Trail and various Exhibitions focused worksheets are available as suggested. Also applicable to Scouts / Cubs / Guides & Beavers is the Air Activities Badge worksheets. A free copy is available on enquiry for reproduction or can be provided by the Museum at 50p per copy.

A full Risk Assessment for such visits **MUST** be made by the Group Organiser prior to the visit and guidelines for this can be provided on enquiry. The Organiser takes responsibility for the conduct of the group whilst on site and there must be adequate adult supervision accompanying the group of at least one adult per 10 pupils / children and we accordingly offer these places on a complimentary basis.

The main hazards are the risk of slips, trips and falls so orderly conduct is required at all times. There are significant risks in the hangars, due to low, sharp edges, equipment, etc., **therefore aircraft / vehicle barriers MUST NOT be crossed unless specifically authorised and supervised by a member(s) of the Yorkshire Air Museum staff.**

We request that in general, and particularly if the NAAFI Restaurant facility is utilised, that due consideration is given to our regular visitors and noise is kept to a minimum and over boisterous and potentially hazardous activity is curtailed. This is an historic site and a Memorial to allied aircrews so should be treated with due respect and consideration.
