YORKSHIRE AIR MUSEUM EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS

Workshop Title: 'Early Flight and Military Aviation'

Workshop duration: 40 minutes

Suitable age groups: Year 3 to Year 6

Numbers: maximum of 15 children per workshop

Availability: Monday to Friday.

After a short introduction on the science of flight explaining the basic principles of flying, our Museum guide will take the children on a discovery tour of the various stages and applications of early flight development through to the use of aviation during both WWI and WWII. As part of this tour, the children will be guided through our 'Gasbags to Super Zeppelins' display to look at early military flight during WWI, followed by our 'hands-on' Handley Page Hangar and finish in our main T2 Hangar to discover WWII bomber and fighter aircraft.

Workshop Title: 'Hands-on WWII'

Workshop duration: 40 minutes

Suitable age groups: Year 3 to Year 6

Numbers: maximum of 15 children per workshop

Availability: Monday to Friday.

Using a carefully selected collection of items used in aviation during WWII, our Museum guide will tell the story of the people who flew military planes and bring them to life through the discovery of these objects.

Workshop Title: 'Morse Code'

Workshop duration: 40-45 minutes

Suitable age groups: Year 4 to Year 6

Numbers: 8 to 10 children per group maximum

Availability: Wednesdays only, other days by request depending on availability.

Our 'Radio Shack' experts will take the children on an educational and fun discovery of how Morse code started and give them a chance to experience how a Morse code machine works, and get them to individually send and receive their own messages using the codes.

YORKSHIRE AIR MUSEUM EDUCATIONAL GUIDED TOUR

Tour duration: 1 hour to 90 minutes (tailored to the group's needs)

Suitable age groups: 13+

Our experienced museum guide will take pupils on a discovery tour of Elvington air base retelling the inspiring story of the squadrons and aircrew based at Elvington since 1942. An evocative and entertaining journey back in time where pupils can witness first-hand the rich past of an authentic wartime base as well as learn about the development of aviation from its early days to the present.

Terms & Conditions for School group visits

The Yorkshire Air Museum welcomes school groups for educational visits.

Our History of Flight Trail and Yorkshire Air Museum Discovery worksheets are available as suggested. A free copy of the school activity sheets is available on enquiry for reproduction or can be provided by the Museum at 50p per copy.

A full Risk Assessment for school visits MUST be made by the Group Organiser prior to the visit and guidelines for this can be provided on enquiry. The Organiser takes responsibility for the conduct of the group whilst on site and there must be adequate adult supervision accompanying the group of at least one adult per 10 pupils / children and we accordingly offer these places on a complimentary basis.

The main hazards are the risk of slips, trips and falls so orderly conduct is required at all times. There are significant risks in the hangars, due to low, sharp edges, equipment, etc., **therefore aircraft / vehicle barriers MUST NOT be crossed unless specifically authorised and supervised by a member(s) of YAM staff.**

We request that, in general, and particularly if the NAAFI Restaurant facility is utilised, due consideration is given to our regular visitors and noise is kept to a minimum, over-boisterous and potentially hazardous activity is curtailed. This is an historic site and a Memorial to allied aircrews so should be treated with due respect and consideration.

THE MUSEUM OPENING HOURS ARE 10.00 AM TO 4.00 PM DURING BRITISH WINTER TIME (Nov to March) AND 10.00 AM TO 5.00 PM DURING BRITISH SUMMERTIME (Apr to Oct).
